He saith to him again the second time, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou Me? He saith unto Him, Yea, Lord; Thou knowest that I love Thee.

John 21:16

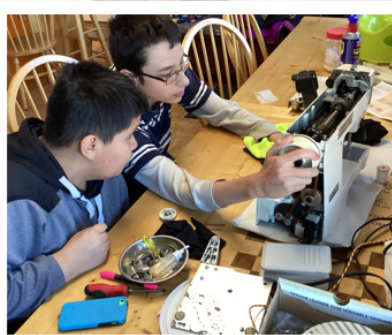

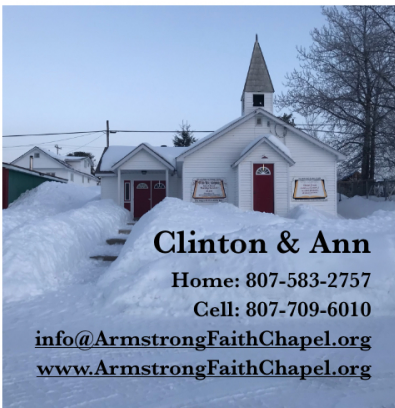
